Financial Sustainability



Conference center leaders will find this seminar helpful to understand and implement financial sustainability in all areas

from operations to major maintenance and capital. Rather than a focus on "what will it cost" students will learn useful ways to determine the impact of operational and program methods in relation to financial return. The content will encourage exploration of new concepts and will be well advanced past traditional thinking and explore new concepts.

- Defining financial sustainability
- Naming and claiming the center's product (real or perceived)
- Measuring the impact of leadership decisions
- "Futurecasting" the effect of debt, credit, cash and depreciation

- Intentionally widening the circle of the center's influence
- Communication with donors, grantors, new markets and communities
- Direct application of the seminar content to the participant's center
